

Kingdom Flow

Luke 9:60

Jesus said to him, "Let the dead bury their own dead, but you go and proclaim the kingdom of God."

Luke 12:20,21

Jesus replied, "The kingdom of God does not come with your careful observation, nor will people say, 'Here it is,' or 'There it is,' because the kingdom of God is within you."

Let's talk about: daily Living out God's Kingdom through my life!

This can only be done within the boundaries of a right relationship with the King. Where is He and where am I?

Do I properly understand Who He is and what my boundaries are?

This means understanding His expectations of His subjects.

My goal must be to please my King!

My life purpose is to allow Him to establish His Kingdom on earth through me.

So, there must be Kingdom Flow. A river flows because that's what it does. It's part of what defines it as a river.

Fruit: in a similar way, the Kingdom Christ showed us must flow out of us naturally, because that's what Kingdom Bringers do.

How does this work practically?

Matthew 22:37 "Jesus replied: " 'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind."

What are the three most common parts of our daily lives?

Attitude, speech and actions. Feeling, speaking and doing.

Make these Kingdom Flow!

How do we facilitate Kingdom Flow on a daily basis?

Let's address these three major parts of our lives: our attitude, speech and actions.

Daily Kingdom Flow:

ATTITUDE

Decisions. Before I decide, I must abide.

Choices. Before I choose, I must lose.

SPEECH

Before I speak, I must seek.

ACTIONS

Before I act, I must fact.

So, practically speaking!

Daily:

I sacrifice my attitude to my King.

I surrender my tongue to my King.

I submit my actions to my King.

How can I know what to feel, think and do?

Ask yourself two questions:

1. Am I pleasing my King?
2. Will His Kingdom flow through me?

In our attitudes, speech and actions, let His Kingdom Flow!
